NOTICE OF EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR PROVISION OF CONSULTANCY SERVICES FOR CARRYING OUT A FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR ADOPTION AND DIFFUSION OF INNOVATIVE WASTE MANAGEMENT TECHNOLOGIES

1. The Ministry of Science, Technology and Innovation (MoSTI) has allocated funds to be used for the acquisition of the consultancy services described above.
2. The Entity now invites eligible consultants to submit sealed expressions of interest for provision of consultancy services for carrying out a feasibility study for adoption and diffusion of Innovative Waste Management Technologies in Uganda. The identified Consultant will carry out a feasibility study and develop a business plan for the project. The Ministry plans to establish four (4) waste high technology management centres, one per region. The role of the Consultant will be to assist the Ministry, through its Project Development Committee (PDC) in conducting a feasibility study for the project. The Consultant will therefore be required to work closely with the PDC and Department of Biosciences and Bioeconomy and any other consultants engaged by the Ministry and its partners in this and related assignments. The overall objective of the assignment is to engage a suitably qualified and experienced consulting firm to provide the Ministry with sufficient information to guide decision making on the kind and nature of activities that will be financed to ensure maximum benefits of the investment.
3. Interested consultants should provide information demonstrating that they are eligible and possess the required qualifications to perform the services supported with relevant documentation.
4. The short listing criteria will include:
 - Experience in similar assignments of at least 3 similar projects performed in the last 5 years.
 - Presence of skills among staff in the areas of:
 - (i) Project Management,
 - (ii) Environmental Science,
 - (ii) Economics/ Financial Analysis and
 - (iii) Social Sciences
 - Experience on at least 1 assignment working in developing countries with conditions similar to Uganda
5. Consultants may associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture or sub consultancy to enhance their qualifications. The form of association, where applicable,

should be indicated and the lead firm in the Expression of Interest. The consultant will be selected in accordance with the Quality and Cost Based Selection method set out in the PPDA Act, 2003 and the PPDA (procurement of consultancy services) Regulations, 2014, after the shortlist is prepared.

6. Preference schemes shall apply when evaluating Request for Proposals from the shortlisted consultants.

8.
